ORDER REGARDING RELEASE ON BOND

When bonding out an inmate who has already been set for a court appearance on a criminal docket, the jail shall, on the bond paperwork, change the time of the inmate's appearance at the criminal docket to the appropriate appearance time for out-of-custody defendants for the judge who has been assigned to hear the defendant's case.

Any PR bond releasing an inmate due to jail overcrowding as authorized by Amended Administrative Order 2018-7 due to overcrowding in the La Plata County jail shall reflect on the PR bond that the PR bond was granted pursuant to Amended Administrative Order 2018-7.

Any inmate who, upon arrival at the jail was intoxicated either by drugs, alcohol or both, who is released pursuant to Amended Administrative Order 2018-7 due to overcrowding in the La Plata County Jail, shall have as a condition of their PR bond that they are released to Pretrial Services on the condition that they not consume or possess any alcoholic beverages or drugs and that they comply with Pretrial Services testing.
