ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2018-13

ORDER REGARDING THE ADVISMENT OF PERSONS ARRESTED ON OUT-OF-COUNTY WARRANTS

Any person who has been arrested within the Sixth Judicial District on a warrant issued from a county in Colorado located outside of the Sixth Judicial District who is unable after 48 hours of arrest to post bond, shall be brought before a judge in the county in which the defendant is being held to be advised at the next regularly scheduled advisement docket. At the advisement hearing no bond modification shall occur regarding the out-of-county warrant.

The court advising the defendant shall issue an order informing the sheriff in the county that issued the arrest warrant that the defendant shall be transported to the demanding county.
