## CHIEF JUDGE ORDER 2025-04

DELEGATING ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY EFFECTIVE: JANUARY 14, 2025

The undersigned, in his capacity as Chief Judge of the 23rd Judicial District and as provided for in Chief Justice Directive ("CJD") 95-01, CJD 04-02, and the Colorado Judicial Department Personnel Rules and Fiscal Procedures, hereby delegates administrative authority to the Court Executive and Chief Probation Officer of the 23rd Judicial District. Pursuant to CJD 95-01, chief judges may delegate authority to the court executive, clerk(s) of court, chief probation officer, and other judicial officers as deemed appropriate. The chief judge maintains ultimate authority and responsibility despite delegation pursuant to CJD 95-01.

The Court Executive of the 23rd Judicial District is delegated responsibility for all administrative matters requiring action within the 23rd Judicial District Trial Courts. The Chief Probation Officer of the 23rd Judicial District is delegated responsibility for all administrative matters requiring action within the 23rd Judicial District Probation Department. These delegations include signature authority.

This delegation of authority shall remain in effect until this Order is otherwise rescinded or replaced, and as may be supplemented by additional Chief Judge Orders of the 23rd Judicial District.
