



<p><b>CHIEF JUDGE ORDER 23-05 AUTHORIZING THE DISMISSAL OF COUNTS IN THE CASE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM WHERE NO CHARGE DISPOSITION EXISTS</b></p>	

Pursuant to the authority granted to chief judges of the judicial districts of the State of Colorado by Chief Justice Directive 95-01, the undersigned, in her capacity as Chief Judge of the Eighteenth Judicial District, enters the following Chief Judge Order (“CJO”) 23-05. This CJO 23-05 authorizes the Clerks of Court in the Eighteenth Judicial District and/or their designees to dismiss counts in the case management system for certain cases (“F” cases, criminal cases, misdemeanor cases, infraction cases, juvenile delinquency cases, and traffic cases) dated prior to

and including 2016 where no charge disposition exists. Only cases that are closed with no active warrant are eligible under this CJO 23-05. In such cases where this CJO 23-05 is applicable, the authorized persons shall enter a minute order in the case management system referencing CJO 23-05 and dismiss outstanding counts where no prior charge disposition exists.
