PRIORITY SCHEDULE FOR APPLYING PAYMENTS TO COURT CASES WHEN DEFENDANT OWES ON MULTIPLE CASES	Courtroom: 3A
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2002-01 - Amended	

When a defendant owes on multiple cases, the schedule set out below will be followed to set payment priorities to the multiple cases of one defendant. If there is more than one case in each case type, the funds will be applied to the oldest case first. All money due in that case will be paid before going on to the next case.

1. Restitution cases with interest
2. Restitution cases without interest
3. JD cases
4. CR cases
5. M cases
6. T cases
7. R cases
8. IA cases (interstate compact)


When a judge orders the defendant to pay in a different order than is set out above, the division staff must enter a minute order on the case and the minute order will be followed.

Exceptions to this rule may be made by the collection investigators and a receipt message will be added so it displays on the receipt and financial screens. However, in any case, the collection investigators will not knowingly deviate from a Judge's order.

If a defendant insists he was instructed to pay a certain case first, and it does not follow the schedule above, check the Register of Actions for a minute order. If further clarification is needed, send the defendant to the Collection Investigator's Office.

This policy amends the policy dated April 19, 2002 and is effective the day it is signed.
